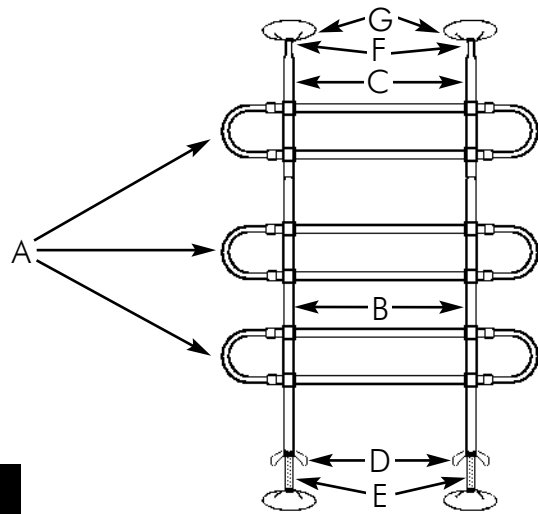
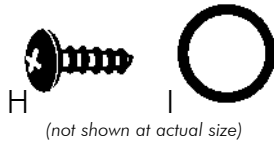


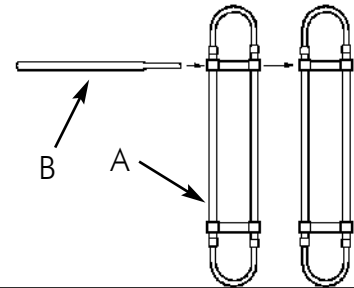
Parts Identification:

- A) 3 - Telescoping hoop assemblies with attached plastic vertical upright support brackets
- B) 2 - Vertical upright tubes
- C) 2 - 9" Upright extension tubes (depending on the interior height of your vehicle, these tubes may not be necessary to use)
- D) 2 - Wing nuts
- E) 2 - Threaded rods
- F) 4 - Support foot inserts
- G) 4 - Support feet
- H) 6 - Screws (Phillips Head)
- I) 2 - Washers

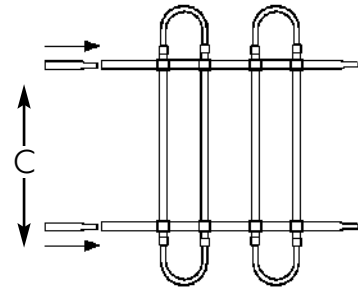

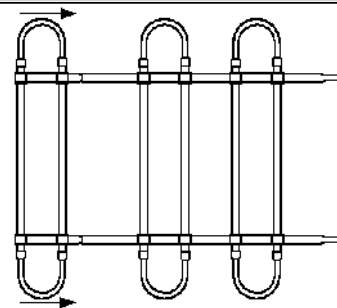
Step 1 Insert vertical upright tubes (B) through 2 of the plastic vertical upright support brackets (A).



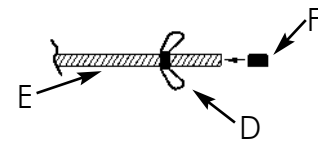
Step 2 Insert the upright extension tubes (C) into the two ends.



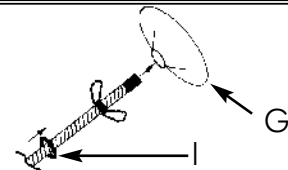
Step 3 Add the remaining telescoping hoop assembly (A) to the upright tube.



Step 4 Turn the wing nut (D) onto the threaded rod (as shown). Press the support foot inserts (F) onto the threaded rod (E). (These inserts may already be in position on the rod)



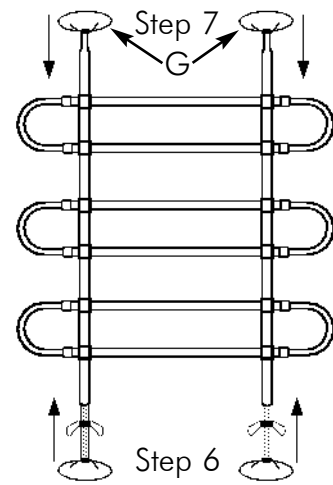
Step 5 At an angle, press the threaded rod with support foot inserts into the support foot (G). Slide the washer (I) on the opposite end so that it meets the flat side of the wing nut.



Step 6 Take the threaded rod/support foot assembly from Steps 4 & 5, and insert into the vertical upright tube from Step 3 assembly. (see illustration for Step 7)

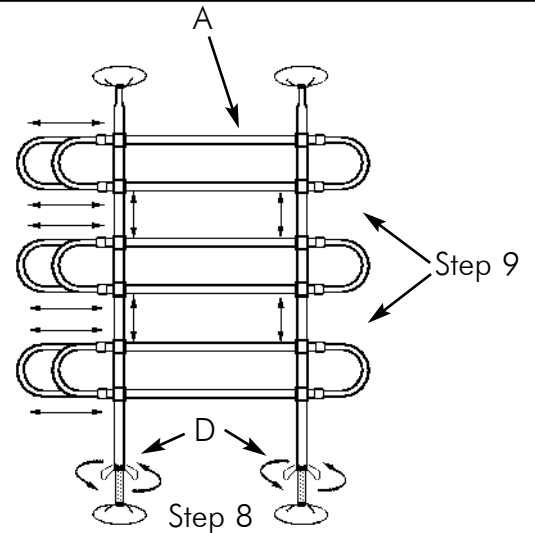
Step 7 Install remaining (2) support feet (G) onto the tops of the vertical upright tubes (B).

Note: Unless already installed, do not use the extra support foot inserts (F).

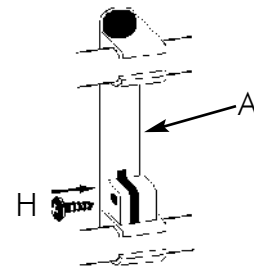


Step 8 At this point, place the unit in your vehicle with the threaded rod assembly portion on the floor and extend it vertically until it is expanded snugly against the roof and floor of the vehicle. Use the wing nuts (D) to make this adjustment.

Step 9 Once the barrier is firmly installed, make adjustments to the telescoping hoop assemblies. Extend the horizontal length and then adjust the telescoping hoop assemblies (A) vertically to optimize barrier.



Step 10 When your barrier is adjusted to your satisfaction, lock your adjustments in place by installing the (6) screws (H). Thread the screws through the thin wall portion (the larger hole) of the plastic vertical upright support brackets (A).



LIMITED WARRANTY

1. For one (1) year from the date of original purchase, MIDWEST Homes For Pets ("MIDWEST") warrants to the purchaser of this pet barrier that, should it prove defective by reason of improper workmanship and/or material, MIDWEST will repair or replace, at its option, any defective part of the barrier, without charge for the part or for shipping. Replacement parts are warranted for the remainder of the original period.

- The customer service representative will determine if the defect is covered by this warranty, and if it is, will authorize and instruct the purchaser in how to obtain corrective action.
- MIDWEST may require the purchaser to present the sales receipt or other proof of purchase prior to authorizing any return or replacement. No returns or replacements will be permitted without proper authorization. If a return or replacement is authorized, you may be requested to return the item to MIDWEST or to make the item available for pick-up by MIDWEST.
